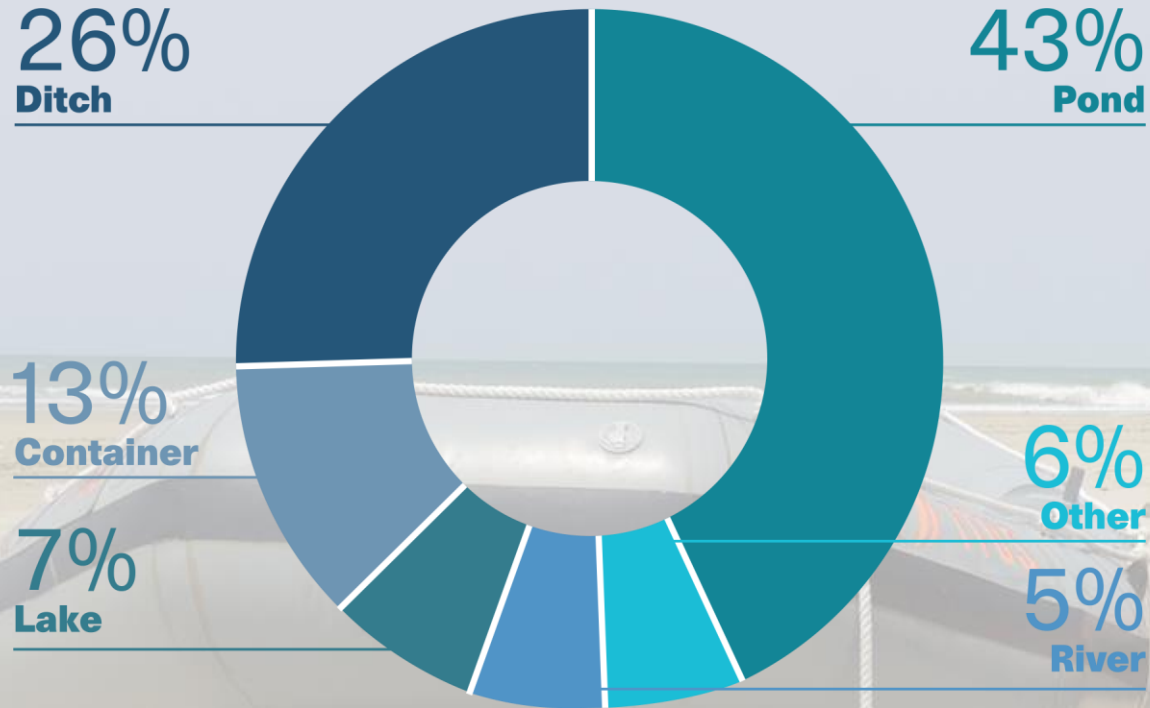

Competence Based Training Methodology for Force Development

We follow a scientific process for developing forces to be adept in search and rescue and to build organizational resilience for sustainable operations.

Step 1 : The first step is to train all members of the force in basic life support training. Following which a swim aptitude test must be taken to assess the participant's interest and capability for water rescue.

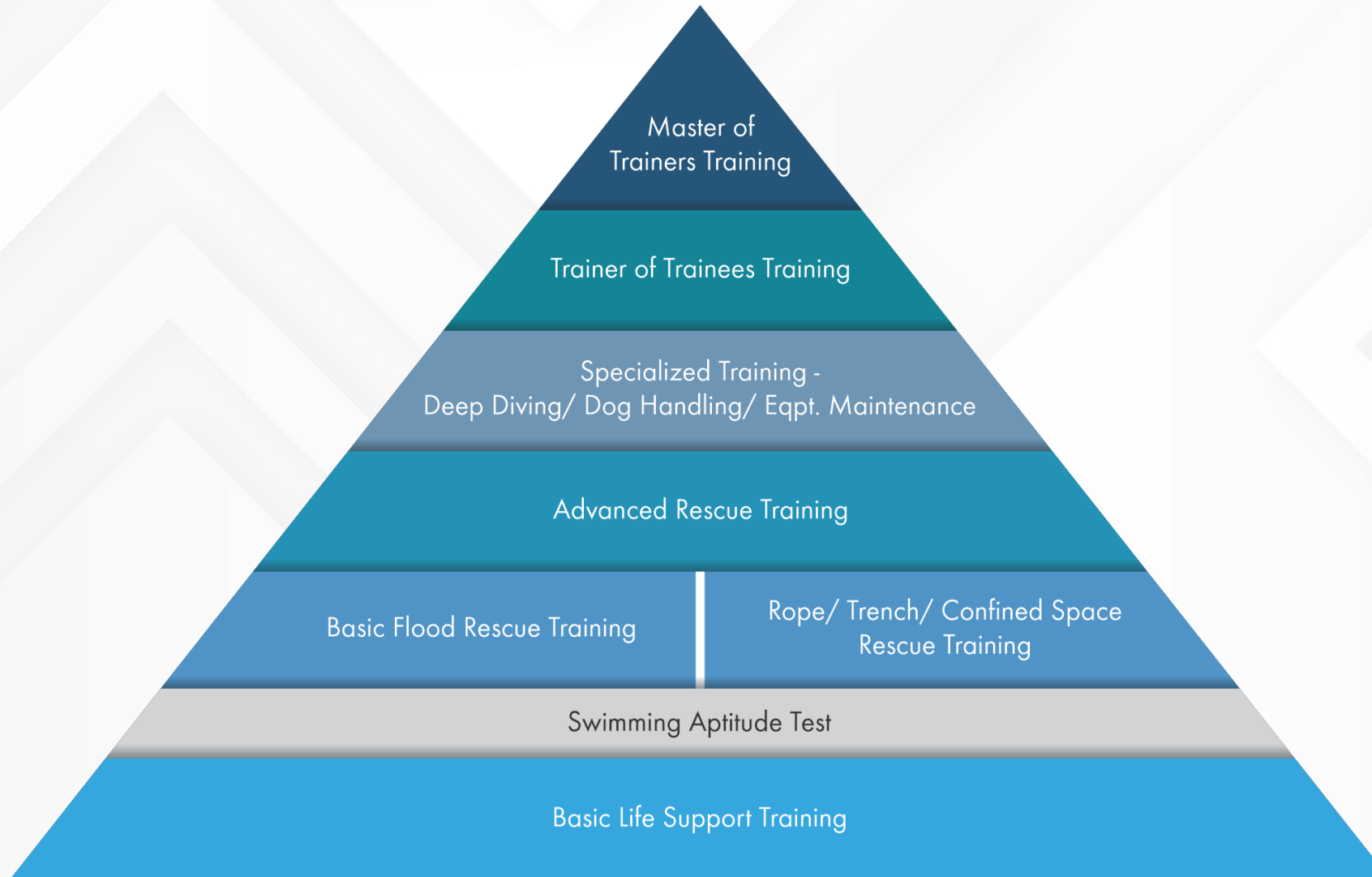
Step 2 : At this stage the force can be effectively divided into land based and water based operators.

Step 3 : On completing basic land/ water based rescue training, it is recommended that top performing participants get the advanced technical rescue knowledge as part of an advanced course. These trained men can be utilized as Quick Reaction Team (QRT) to any disaster to take on life saving actions during the golden hour.

Step 4 : Further, specialized courses like Deep Diving and Dog Handling allow interested volunteers of the force to develop into Special Operation Units.

Step 5 : Highly experienced and conversant volunteers can further undertake detailed studies as part of the Trainer of Trainees (TOT) and Master of Trainers (MOT) courses where they will ensure self reliance of the organization in raising its own forces.

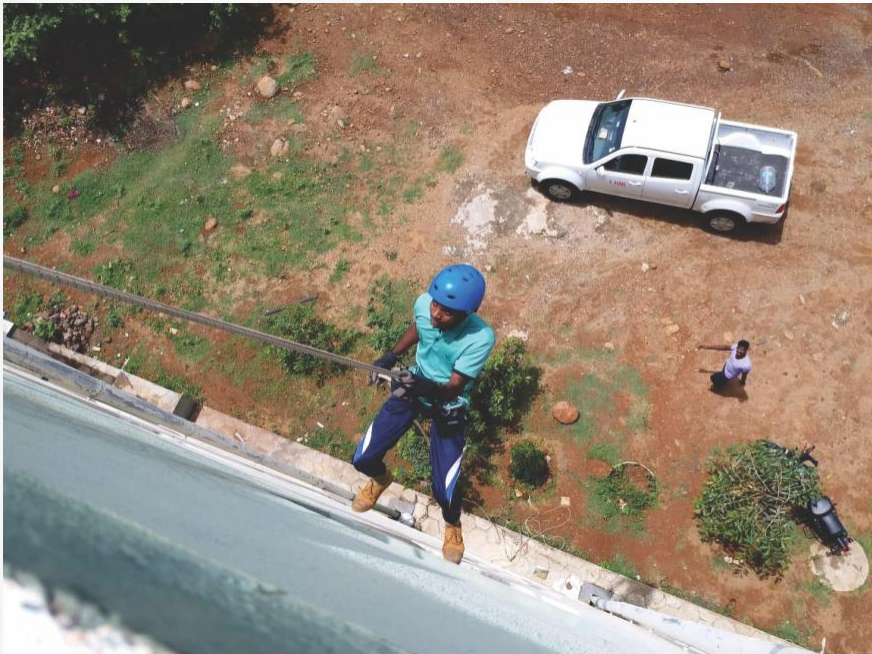

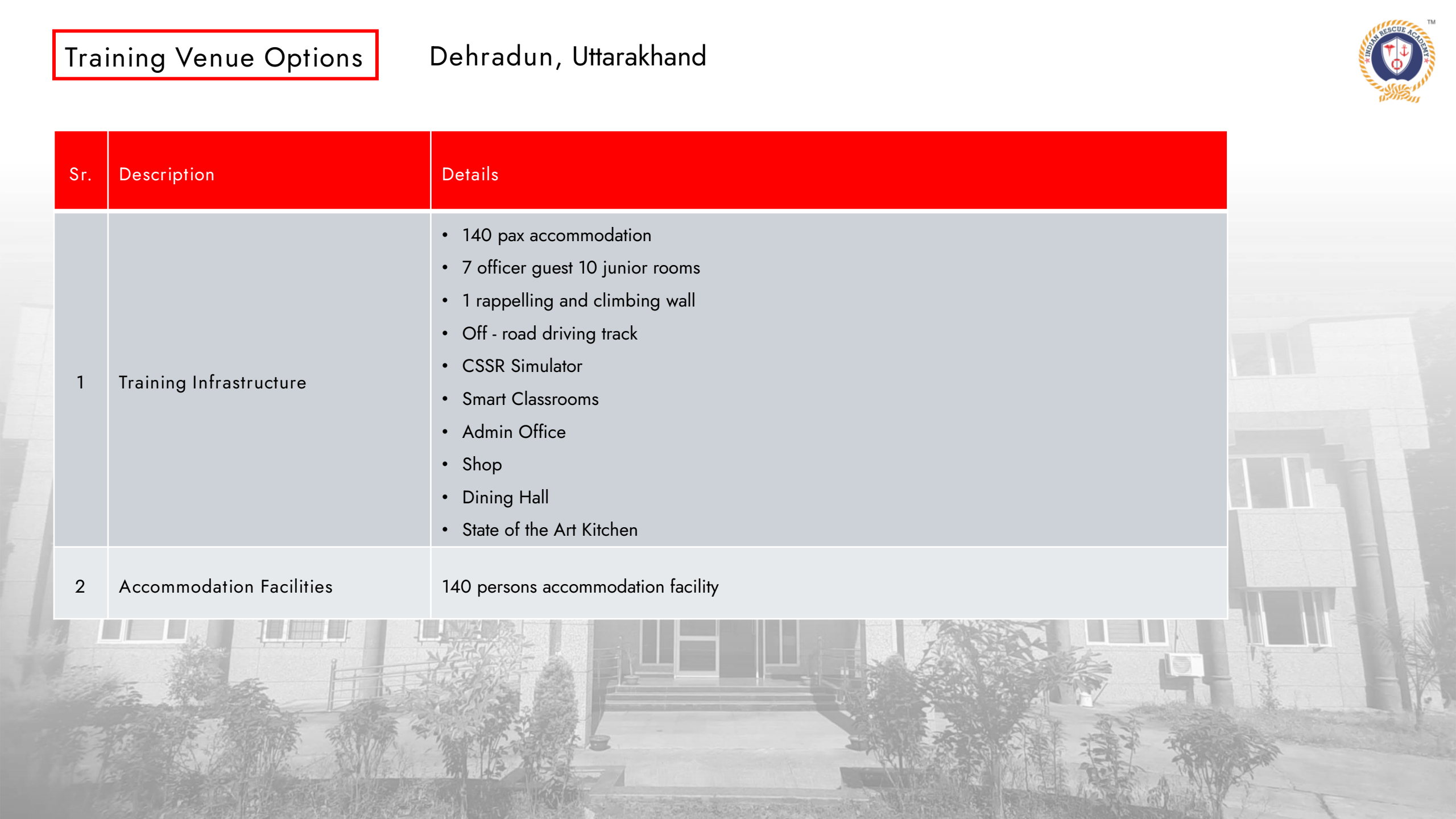

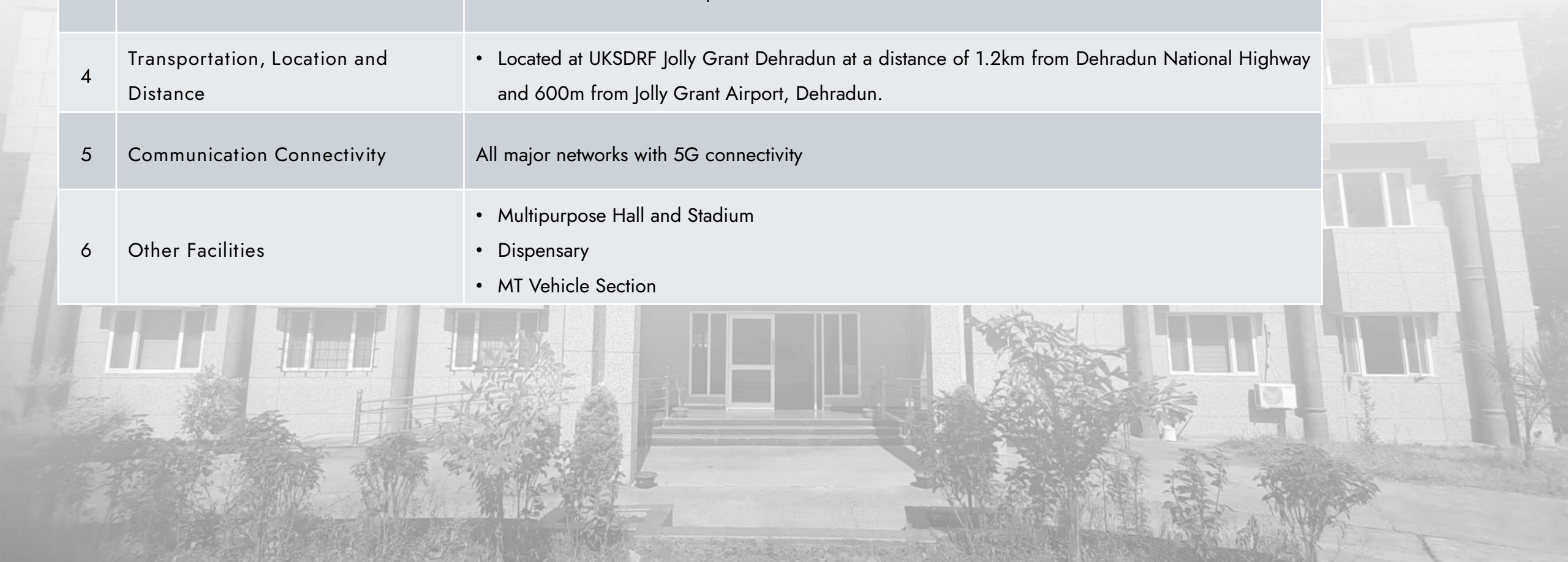
